- In February 2022 we replaced all 361 bedroom mattresses using sustainable and EDG conscious suppliers
 - We replaced the bulbs in our ballroom chandeliers with LED lighting
 - We donate to our local food bank on a weekly basis and have donated 502 total meals to date
- We have reduced our usage of water equivalent to 18 Olympic swimming pools
 - We have completed 4,962 volunteer hours so far
 - We use 100% renewable energy for electricity



Did you know that Wembley Park are experts in revolutionising waste removal?



Envac is one of the most innovative players in the global automated waste collection and the inventor of the pneumatic waste collection system. They lead the design and implementation of next generation recycling using resource efficient waste handling.

By 2025, 24,000 Wembley residents will use the system that will handle up to 6,000 tonnes of waste and recycling per year and remove 700 tonnes of vehicle emissions from the local environment.

Our hotel uses Wembley's Envac station, located directly next door, where the sorting, recycling and waste to energy is undertaken on our behalf by the complex. This insures we have zero wastage as any waste produced is successfully turned to energy and NOT landfill.
